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Preface

Amanjaya 2017 Module is a self-instructional package module; a language learner should be able to use this module at their own pace with minimal guidance from the ESL teachers. There are three major sections worth a mention. **Section A** covers mostly on *Grammar*, **Section B** covers *Comprehensions* and *Social Expressions* and **Section C** is for *Writing*.

The exercises and notes in this module were produced by Key Trainers from various parts of Perak. Yet, it is far from perfect and of course there will be occasional errors throughout the module.

Some of the questions and items were taken from previous Amanjaya Module. Thanks to feedbacks from many Language teachers, certain aspects have been weighed and that includes the continuation from the previous module.
